







Year 13 Transition tasks: Observation studies

Produce at least 5 observational studies from life or your own photographs using different media and approaches. Ensure that all work links with your self-set project theme and is presented and annotated.


Recording, by drawing and other suitable means, such as colour, tonal and textural notes, photographs and annotation in sketchbooks and on study sheets, ideas, observations and insights that are in line with personal intentions.

Critical reflection on progression of work in order to effectively review what has been learned, acquire deeper understanding and clarify purposes and meanings.

Where appropriate, learning could be transferred to new contexts, such as adapting an expressive, abstract painted response to cross sections of fruit in order to develop graphic designs for new, locally-produced fruit yoghurts.
